





What we will be learning: Most students should be able to:

- \star
- Addition and subtraction fact fluency Paragraph with proper capitalization and punctuation. (narrative, informational, & opinion) \star
- Solves number stories with addition, subtraction, and \star missing addends
- Partition shapes into equal parts Tell time to the hour & half hour \star
- \star
- Read a variety of books independently with fluency, \star expression
- Retell a story with main events, character, setting, main \star idea, and central message
- Can count a collection of pennies, nickels, dimes, and \star quarters up to .99 cents
- Have a basic understanding of non-standard \star measurement
- Understands place value \star





5 ways to help your child succeed in school

- 1. <u>Get a head start</u>: introduce some of the curriculum to your child over the summer:
- ★ Addition/Subtraction, coin identification & value
- 2. <u>Read.ing:</u>
- ★ Repeated reading, story elements, vocabulary, high frequency words, letter sounds
 - 3. Encourage Trying:
- ★ Encourage independence, learning from mistakes, growth mindset
- 4. <u>Send them off on the right foot:</u>
- ★ Good, nutritious breakfast and lunch, sleep, backpack prepared
- 5. <u>Be involved:</u>
- ★ Communicate with the teacher, check Seesaw & red folder daily



Attendance: Studies show...





- ★ Developing a habit of good attendance will help your child do well in school, college and work
- ★ Attendance matters in every grade
- ★ Though some absences are unavoidable, too many can affect student success, whether the absences are excused or unexcused
- ★ Setting a regular bedtime and morning routine will help with being on time to school
